- Students must complete all required components of the IB Diploma Programme including all subject assessments for the six DP courses, the Extended Essay, the Theory of Knowledge course, and Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS).
- Although Kaiser High School pays for the IB annual fee, teacher training, and resources, families must pay the IB DP student registration and subject fees during the first year in the program. The total for registration and subject fees for this program ranges from \$900 to \$1000, which is dependent upon the IB Organization's fee schedule.
- Students are not allowed to withdraw from the program or change classes after the first two weeks in the program.

Agreement for the IB Career-related Programme



- Students must complete all required components of the IB Career-related Programme including two years in a CTE pathway, the Personal and Professional Skills course, Service Learning, Language Development, the Reflective Project, and all subject assessments for DP courses.
- Although Kaiser High School pays for the IB annual fee, teacher training, and resources, families must pay the IB CP student registration and subject fees during the first year in the program. The total for registration and subject fees for this program ranges from \$400 to \$500, which is dependent upon the IB Organization's fee schedule.
- Students are not allowed to withdraw from the program or change classes after the first two weeks of the school year.
